

• School divisions have now received clarification and communication about the impact that might be felt should any variant strains of the Covid-19 virus be found in schools.

Highlights include stricter protocols when variant cases are identified in schools. One of the most impactful changes is that entire households now must isolate if a household member is deemed to be a close contact of a confirmed Covid-19 case. The whole household may be quarantine for anywhere from 10 to 24 days depending upon the circumstances outlined clearly in the document.

It remains critically important to stay vigilant in following existing protocols so that our communities as a whole remain safe and healthy. Sunrise School Division will share any further information from Manitoba Education and/or Manitoba Health as soon as it is available.

Sunrise School Division still works with the Health Authority to report, contact trace, and communicate any identified cases by letter, phone message, and on our website. It is very important for all staff, students, and community members to continue following public health directives to help keep our schools safe learning spaces.
